Under limited supervision, perform complex installations, disconnects and service changes for residential and business customers. Perform basic troubleshooting and repair for services from tap to consumer's electronic devices (TV, VCR, Modem, etc.)</p>	
Responsibilities: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Perform repair and maintenance on multiple services including video, data and voice• Perform all diagnostic, auditing, leakage detection, and record keeping expected of a Broadband Tech II; identify causes of picture and/or signal degradation; assist in outages as needed• Perform quality control inspections by reviewing work completed by contract and in-house installers• Assist in providing training to Broadband Technician I and II• Perform installations, troubleshoot and repair customer cable and data services from the first active plant device to the connection of the customer's equipment for single, multi-family, commercial dwellings and/or business service, including, as appropriate, all necessary wiring (interior and exterior) and hardware; install, troubleshoot and repair drops from tap to cable modem• Troubleshoot distribution and entire return-path problems from tap to CPE (including troubleshooting, repairing or replacing defective or damaged components and/or installing new taps); install and configure network interface cards and client software on residential and business computer equipment; identify problems with customer's system configurations and settings that interfere with use of the service• Perform repair and maintenance on voice systems, including uninstalling and removing existing CPE; install, uninstall, and reconnect NIU devices and backup powering; initiate DHCP script• Educate customer on proper use of services, including how to add additional services and access help online• Perform all work as necessary to conform to quality control guidelines (includes compliance with requirements outlined in applicable regulations such as: OSHA, FCC, and NEC, etc and following procedures)• Perform installation, troubleshooting and repair for connects (new connects and reconnections), disconnects (requested and non-pays), upgrades, downgrades, and relocates; install additional outlets, and install or remove equipment; connect various options available with customer's equipment per

Qualifications:

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- NCTI or SCTE certification preferred
- Requires at least one year as BBT II
- BBT III assessment within 12 months
- Valid driver's license
- Satisfactory driving record
- Knowledge of basic mathematics and electronics
- Knowledge of and ability to operate appropriate testing equipment (e.g. signal level meters, ohm meters, etc.)
- Ability to accurately measure distances, using tapes or other measuring devices
- Ability to adhere to Local, Federal regulations and Company policies
- Ability to drive Company vehicle in a safe and responsible manner
- Ability to make cable connections in tight spaces by bending, reaching, twisting
- Ability to operate appropriate computer or test equipment associated with position
- Ability to perform job from high places (i.e. poles and roofs)
- Knowledge of Return Path portion of cable plant operations
- Knowledge of National Electric Code and National Electrical Safety Code
- Work performed near power lines and electricity
- Work and travel in inclement weather

Essential Job Functions:

- Ability to carry, climb and operate extension ladder, (approx. 28 ft high and 75 pounds)
- Ability to climb poles using gaffs, hooks and climbing belt as needed
- Ability to differentiate between different sizes and colors of wires
- Ability to work while standing 50 - 70% of the time
- Ability to walk over all types of terrain in all kinds of weather while carrying tools and equipment, including gaffs, ladders, and fully loaded tool belts
- Ability to work with small components and wires to make cable connections
- Work indoors in poorly ventilated areas such as attics during extreme heat
- Exposure to dust, dirt, noise, insects, cleaning solutions
- Work outdoors in all kinds of weather and at all times of the day or night
